

Important Safety Instructions

PORTABLE CART

- 1. Read these instructions.
- 2. Keep these instructions.
- **3.** Heed all warnings.
- 4. Follow all instructions.
- **5.** Do not use this apparatus near water.
- **6.** Clean only with a dry cloth.
- **7.** Do not block any ventilation openings. Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
- **9.** Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding-type plug. A polarized plug has two blades with one wider than the other. A grounding-type plug has two blades and a third grounding prong. The wide blade or the third prong are provided for your safety. If the provided plug does not fit into your outlet, consult an electrician for replacement of the obsolete outlet.
- 10. Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the apparatus.
- **11.** Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- **12.** Use only with a cart, stand, tripod, bracket, or table specified by the manufacturer, or sold with the apparatus. When a cart is used, use caution when moving the cart/apparatus combination to avoid injury from tip-over.





Rupert Neve Designs 543: Mono Compressor-Limiter

Thank you for purchasing the Rupert Neve Designs 543 mono compressor-limiter. We hope you enjoy using this product as much as we have enjoyed designing and building it. The 543 was designed to provide precise and powerful level control in an accessible single-slot 500 series format. The 543 features a fully controllable compressor-limiter with feed-forward / feedback modes, Peak / RMS detection and a built-in side chain high pass filter.

543 Front Panel Features

THRESHOLD

Center-detent potentiometer that controls the compressor threshold range from +20dBu to -30dBu.

S/C HPF

Push-button switch that engages the side-chain high pass filter. The HPF is fixed at 250Hz with a 12dB/octave slope.

LEVEL METER

8-segment LED meter that indicates output level.

RATIO

Center-detent potentiometer that controls the compressor ratio within a range of 1.1:1 to 40:1.

ATTACK

Center-detent potentiometer that controls the compressor attack time within a range of 20mS to 75mS.

F/F or F/B

Push-button switch that toggles between 'feed-forward' or 'feed-back' modes. Feed-back mode references the output signal post-VCA to control the attenuation. Feed-forward mode references the output signal pre-VCA to control the attenuation.

RELEASE

Center-detent potentiometer that controls the compressor release time within a range of 100mS to 2.5S.

RMS or PEAK

Push-button switch that toggles between 'RMS' or 'PEAK' detection modes. In RMS (root mean square) mode the compressor responds to a loudness average over time. In PEAK mode the compressor responds directly to waveform voltage, which can be more effective to prevent clipping.

GR METER

8-segment LED meter that indicates gain reduction.

MAKE-UP GAIN

Center-detent potentiometer that controls the compressor make-up gain within a range of -6 to +20dB.

IN

Push-button switch that illuminates GREEN when the compressor is engaged.

LINK

Switch that engages stereo compressor link mode.


